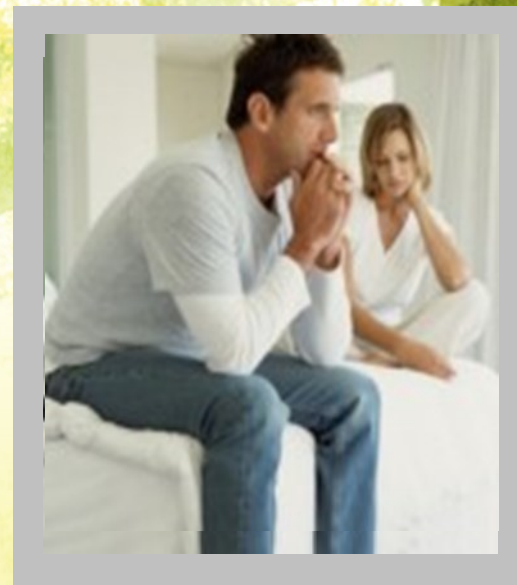

Why Can't You Quit?

Monthly group therapy sessions are designed for clients and their family members ages 13 and up who are concerned about a loved one's use of alcohol or other drugs and the related consequences.



You are not alone!

It's estimated that 1 out of every 10 people who use alcohol and approximately 6 out of every 10 who use other drugs develop alcoholism or other drug addiction / dependency.

The stigma associated with addiction prevents family members from identifying the problem and seeking appropriate help.

Thoughts like, "it can't happen in my family," or "it's just a phase they're going through," can fuel years of denial, during which time overwhelming emotional and financial difficulties take their toll.



Education Group

The goal of family therapy is to provide participants with basic information about alcohol and other drug use, possible addiction and other related issues including the possible negative impact on the family system. These topics assist group members in establishing healthy boundaries and recognizing the difference between responding to the user or a related situation rather than taking responsibility for the consequence or the user. Participation in the group is free.

Why Can't you Quit? provides a structured, caring environment for parents and other family members who are seeking to break the dysfunctional enabling cycle with their addicted loved one while making healthier choices for themselves and those they love. Participants are free to share their common strength and hope through their past and present experiences, without fear of reprisal, judgment or negative feedback. Participation in Why Can't You Quit? is free.
